| Header/Footer Won't Change | Section breaks or <i>Link to Previous</i> turned on | Layout → Breaks → check section breaks Double-click header/footer → turn off Link to Previous Check Different First Page settings Review → Stop Protection if locked |
| Page Numbers Display Incorrectly | Section breaks or numbering restart | Layout → Breaks → remove unwanted breaks Double-click footer → Format Page Numbers → Continue from previous section Insert → Page Number → reapply if missing |
| Spelling / Grammar Check Not Working | Proofing disabled or incorrect language | File → Options → Proofing → tick spelling & grammar boxes Ctrl+A → Review → Language → Set Proofing Language Copy text into a new document |

| File Corruption / Document Won't Open | File corrupted or unsupported format | File → Open → Open and Repair Try Safe Mode (Ctrl + double-click Word icon) Try opening in Google Docs |
| Lost Unsaved Document | Power failure or unsaved changes | File → Info → Manage Document → Recover Unsaved Documents Check AppData → AutoRecover folder Look for Backup of [filename] |
| Word Keeps Crashing / Freezing | Add-ins, outdated updates, corrupted template | Restart computer File → Options → Add-ins → Disable Update Office & Windows Scan for malware |
| Slow Performance (Large Files) | Tracked changes, images, or file size | Accept all tracked changes Compress images (File → Options → Advanced → Image Size & Quality) Split document into smaller parts |

P Extra Tips

- AutoRecover: Word auto-saves versions. Reopen Word after a crash to recover lost files.
- Backup Often: Save in .docx format and sync to OneDrive or Google Drive.
- **Keep Word Updated:** Regular updates fix bugs and compatibility issues.
